**Dear friends in the Kingdom of God,**

I always **do enjoy** writing to you sharing what God let me and my family do for Him.

**I started January preaching, and finished that month preaching too.** On January 1-3 I ministered in Sullana, Cieneguillo Centro, and Paita. It was quick trip; I went with Noe, my oldest son. I encouraged pastors on that area to work harder on missions.

**My trip to San Roque was the most noticeable trip (January 12-24).** San Roque is a town located beside the Ucayali River. The Church there was ministered by American missionaries 50 years ago. According to some brethren, in that Ucayali River area there were several Baptist churches, but by lack of discipleship and preachers to visit those churches, some churches are closed, and other churches fell under cults or denominational control. I went to that area with 7 adults and one girl. We all worked in organized way to serve children, ladies and gentlemen in separated groups. We also preached in evening meetings; and also shared the gospel with other travelers on the boat during the round trip. We calculate that 400+ people heard the gospel. **On February** I will spend the first two weeks for my family, and the other two weeks I will be serving in Iquitos and Requena. In Iquitos I will be preaching in a Youth Camp and some churches. In Requena I will continue with pastors and leaders training.
